**Accommodation in Tradition Hotel Kultahovi 2 nights** 



#### Fishing in the River under the Midnight Sun

Rivers in Inari hold good populations of grayling, trout and pike. River fishing season in Inari starts first of June and goes on till the end of August. (1.6. – 30.8.) Every month offers different kind of fishing and also the "hot specie" changes. Your <u>local fishing guide Atte Ikkala</u> knows where to be at the time of your visit in Inari.

## Wilderness Drive from Inari to Lemmenjoki

Inari is locate by the Lake Inari, and from there is a short drive to Lemmenjoki. Lemmenjoki is located in the one of the biggest wilderness areas in Europe. This small village is a home for couple of Sámi families - all of them are working with reindeer herding. Our host Paltto family also welcomes visitors to their reindeer farm.





## Experience Authentic Sámi Culture in the Legendary Lemmenjoki!

The best way for you to explore the magnificent nature of the Lemmenjoki River is on a boat trip to the national park guided by the local Paltto family. The Sámi family of Paltto have been reindeer herding for generations. In addition to the accommodation, we also offer you a wide range of experiences in the legendary Lemmenjoki river valley surrounded by the fells, the beautiful Ravadas waterfall and the remote gold panning area in the wilderness. You will learn about the fascinating Sámi culture and reindeer herding, hear traditional Sámi joik song and can feed the reindeer. A wilderness lunch prepared in a campfire – what an authentic Arctic culinary experience! You can also visit the Feltmaker's studio with a sales exhibition.





## **Local Culinary Experience - Dinner at the Aanaar Restaurant**

The Aanaar Restaurant, for example, northern forest blueberries, a cow parsley growing along the riverside, whitefish from Lake Inari, the king crab of the Arctic Ocean or reindeer from a nearby bar in many forms bring taste to the plate. Come and see how sweetgrass replaces the vanilla stick in desserts and how a short trip from the lake to the plate really makes a difference on the taste buds. Our kitchen is constantly looking for new ingredients in the local area and researching the cultural traditions of our area for processing them on a plate.

## DAY 5: Atlantic Salmon Fishing or Kingcrab Fishing - Overnight in Nuorgam



#### **Atlantic Salmon Fly Fishing in Neiden River**

Neiden River flows in Eastern Finnmark of Norway right on the Finnish boarder. Fishing here doesn't require long distance hiking and most of the best pools are right next to the road. It's possible to catch really big salmon, sea run brown trout and grayling through the whole fishing season of June, July and August.

#### Boat Excursion on Teno River - the Boarder between Finland & Norway

Tenojoki is the longest and most important salmon river in Europe and marks the border between Finland and Norway. The trip is done aboard a traditional riverboat to Alaköngäs during the Midnight Sun or in the daytime later in the autumn. DAY 7: The Most Beautiful Road in Finland & Giellajohka in the Wilderness



#### The Most Beautiful Road in Finland by Teno River

The River Teno is one of the largest and best salmon rivers in Europe. Teno – Deatnu in Northern Sámi and Tana in Norwegian – is the border of Finland and Norway and therefore forms also the northern border of the European Union. The beautiful river valley of Teno with its hidden sandy beaches is overlooked by rugged fells, creating unforgettable arctic scenery.

The road takes you from Nuorgam to Karigasniemi to Utsjoki following the River Teno. This "Route Teno" has been given the title of the most beautiful route in Finland as it travels alongside the river through breathtakingly beautiful river valley – you cannot find anything like it elsewhere in Finland.





## Overnight in Giellajohka for 2 nights by the Wilderness River

<u>Giellajohka</u> is in the heart of Lapland, halfway between the villages of Kaamanen and Karigasniemi offering comfortable accommodation and exciting activities all year round.

The location in the middle of the wilderness areas of Muotkatunturi and Paistunturi guarantees you great opportunities to enjoy the unique nature of Lapland.
