

## FEES FOR SPORTS FACILITIES

- Single ticket EUR 3, discounted price EUR 2
  - Ivalo public gym, Urheilutalo badminton fee, Ivalo public swimming pool
  - a single purchase of more than 10 tickets (EUR 3 tickets), tickets at a discounted price of EUR 20
- Sports pass EUR 12 per month, discounted EUR 7 per month
  - Ivalo public gym, Urheilutalo badminton fee, Ivalo public swimming pool, Inari gym (you must also purchase an access badge for the Inari gym)
  - 1 to 12 months
  - After the 15th, the fee will be reduced to EUR 7
- Electrical access key EUR 10
  - one-time purchase, you keep the key
  - updated according to the validity of your sports pass
  - only granted to adults
- Senior pass, free of charge for those over 70 years of age
  - Ivalo public gym Mon-Thu from 12 to 20, Fri from 12 to 18, Urheilutalo badminton fee, Ivalo public swimming pool, Inari gym Mon-Fri from 8 to 12
  - does NOT include a key
    - if you want a key (use of the Ivalo public gym Mon-Sun from 6 to 22, Inari gym Mon-Fri from 7 to 21, Sat-Sun from 9 to 20) you must pay the price of a discounted sports pass, EUR 7
- Company pass EUR 20 per month
  - Ivalo public gym, Urheilutalo badminton fee, Ivalo public swimming pool, Inari gym
  - granted for 3 to 12 months
  - only serves as an admission fee for one person at a time
  - order company passes from the secretary of leisure services mervi.urpilainen@inari.fi
  - indicate in the order: company name, business ID, invoicing address, responsible person's name and contact details

Discounted price: students, unemployed people, pensioners, conscripts, children

A sports pass and single tickets can be paid with sports vouchers (Smartum, Virike, and Kuntoseteli).

Electronic sports vouchers (payment cards) can only be used to pay at the info point at the town hall between Mon-Fri from 9 to 15.

The fees are based on the decision of the Education and Culture Board on 11 December 2013 Sivistyspalvelujen maksut 1.1.2014 alkaen. (Fees for education and culture services from 1 January 2014.)
