

RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE IVALO PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL DURING THE MUNICIPALITY'S PUBLIC OPENING HOURS

1. The swimming pool is located in a military area, moving around in the area

- park cars in the parking area, bikes in bike racks
- entrance from the main door of the swimming pool building
- other movement in the area is prohibited
- unwarranted staying in the swimming pool premises is prohibited

2. Basic activities in the swimming pool

- swimming supervisor must be obeyed and not unnecessarily disturbed
- children under 8 years of age are only allowed to enter the swimming pool with a guardian
- children with no swimming skills are the guardian's responsibility
- a child who can swim at least 25 metres is considered to have swimming skills
- you must behave calmly in the swimming pool and take other users into account
- jumping into the pool is only allowed at the deep end of the pool
- observe general cleanliness litter (e.g., empty shampoo bottles) in the litter bin
- breakdowns, accidents, and disappearances must be reported immediately to the swimming supervisor on site (the one who caused an intentional breakdown must compensate for it)
- lost property must be handed over to the swimming supervisor
- the municipality is not responsible for lost money, valuables, or other equipment

3. In the swimming pool, it is prohibited

- to yell and make noise
- to run in dressing rooms and at the pool
- to jump from the edges of the pool
- to hang in the pool ropes
- to play and stay in the swim lane intended for workout
- to throw swimming equipment (rings, floats, boards, balls, etc.)
- to apply shampoo or similar substances to floors
- to eat your lunch in dressing rooms, washing rooms, and at the pool
- to bring in glass bottles and other fragile items
- to smoke and use other similar tobacco products
- to use or possess alcohol or drugs or present oneself under their influence

4. Hygiene in the swimming pool

• you must wash yourself before entering the sauna



- you must go to the sauna without a swimming suit
- after the sauna, you must wash yourself before entering the pool
- you must wear swimwear (use of shorts prohibited) before entering the pool
- you must also wash yourself after a toilet visit

5. Ticket sales

- ticket sales for public opening hours end 60 minutes before the end of the opening hours (the front door of the swimming pool is locked)
- you must leave the pool 30 minutes before the end of the opening hours

6. Compliance with the rules

- swimming supervisor has the right to remove a person who violates the rules from the swimming pool
- a temporary or permanent ban may be issued on repeated infringements
